Welcome to this week's newsletter.

Today is the First Sunday of Advent and the beginning of a new liturgical year – so Happy New Year! Advent is the season of hope, expectancy and preparation for the coming of the Christ Child. May this be a grace filled season for each of you. It is my favourite season, I love advent, and there are lots of things happening to aid us in our celebration of Advent and preparation for Christmas. Each Sunday there is a different focus for us, this Sunday it is supporting the food bank – giving something of ourselves.
